In the years that followed, the determination for enosis continued. On 3 April Boutros Boutros-Ghali the new UN Secretary-General, presented the Security Council with the outline plan for the creation of a bi-zonal, bi-communal federation that would prohibit any form of partition, secession or union with another state. Meanwhile, Turkish troops did not refrain from extending their positions, and Tassos Papadopoulos the president of Cyprus, in a speech delivered on 7 April called on Greek Cypriots to reject the plan. He viewed the problem in communal terms. In February renewed negotiations to settle the Cyprus dispute began after the years that followed, the determination for enosis continued.
