publishing, which produces a great variety of material, from complete symphonic scores to sheet music of the latest popular hit. Many medieval manuscripts attained a high perfection of colour and form and are renowned for their beauty.

Translation rights have become a valuable source of additional revenue, particularly in the case of popular fiction. The first magazine had considerable initial success, but by the early 1800s it was losing money and was discontinued. Printing began to settle down, to become regulated from within and controlled from without, only after about 1800.
