Invited to dine at the Brighton Pavilion he met Sheridan, with whom the Prince of Wales was intimate. The attacks on Hastings were largely made by opposition Whigs hoping to embarrass the government of William Pitt. But Hastings was vulnerable on episodes such as the execution of Nandakumar and his treatment of the begums of Oudh and Chait Singh and even on some aspects of his personal finances, where he had acquired money in excess of his official allowances. The powers of the Governor General were balanced out by the establishment of a Calcutta Council which had the authority to veto his decisions. Although the company did not at this stage intend to set itself up as the actual government of India, it put the native courts in the interior entirely under the control of the head revenue officers, with a chief court for criminal appeals at the seat of government under a native chief justice.
